Town Board Meeting Highlights

December 8, 2021

This monthly meeting started at 7:00pm and lasted 76 minutes at Town Hall and via Zoom. Five people attended at Town Hall, and 16 families connected via Zoom.

Supervisor Horton emphasized that the Town submitted final voucher paperwork to NYS DEC for reimbursement of the third year of the Lake Stewards Grant Project. This \$60,989.00 3-year project has been highly successful, and plans are underway to submit a new proposal in 2022.

The Supervisor reported that no new public information is available about the Golf Club House.
