LOCAL LAW NO. 1 FOR THE YEAR 1973

A LOCAL LAW to regulate the operation of snowmobiles on public highways and places in the Town of Caroga, New York.

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Caroga, New York, as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Intent.

1. The purpose of this local law is to protect the public health, welfare and safety by regulating the operation of snowmobiles on public highways and places for vehicular and pedestrian travel and other uses, and which will promote the safety and proper use of snowmobiles for recreation and commerce and minimize detrimental effects of such use on the environment.

Section 2. Definitions.

1. The terms, words and phrases used in this local law shall have the same meaning as such terms, words and phrases are defined in section 21.05 of the Parks and Recreation Law.

2. Whenever the word Town is used herein it shall mean the Town of Caroga, New York.

Section 3. Operation on Town streets, highways, parks, public places or parts thereof.

1. Operation of snowmobiles on streets, highways, parks, public highways or portions thereof of the Town and of

the County of Fulton shall be subject to the applicable provisions of articles twenty-one through twenty-seven of the Parks and Recreation Law, the rules and regulations of the Office of Parks and Recreation.

2. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive or operate any snowmobile on any Town street, highway, park, public place or any portion thereof unless the Town Board adopts a resolution permitting the use as follows:

(a) That such resolution should designate such Town street, highway, park, public place or portion thereof, and

(b) That such resolution should authorize the Town Highway Superintendent to post signs or markers thereon as provided in Section 25.09 of the Parks and Recreation Law.

Section 4. Violations.

1. A violation of any of the provisions of this local law shall be punishable as provided in Section 27.11 of the Parks and Recreation Law.

Section 5. Separability.

1. If any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph,

subdivision or section of this local law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such portion of this local law shall be deemed separate and distinct from the remainder of this local law and such judgment shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this local law.

Section 6. Effective Date.

1. This local law shall take effect immediately upon its filing in accordance with the provisions of section twenty-seven of the Municipal Home Rule Law, provided, however, that no snowmobile shall be operated under the provisions hereof until such time as the signs and markers are installed or constructed in accordance with the requirements of article twenty-five of the Parks and Recreation Law and the rules and regulations of the New York State Office of Parks and Recreation.
