**Local Law No. 1 for the Year 1995**

**A local law: ESTABLISHING A SAFETY ZONE PROHIBITING  
THE USE OF FIREARMS OR DANGEROUS  
WEAPONS WITHIN THE ZONE ESTABLISHED  
IN THE TOWN OF CAROGA**

**Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Caroga as follows:**

- Section 1: Title
- Section 2: Definitions
- Section 3: Legislative Intent
- Section 4: Prohibited Use of Firearms and Dangerous Weapons Within the Safety Zone
- Section 5: Rules and Regulations
- Section 6: Enforcement
- Section 7: Penalties
- Section 8: Validity
- Section 9: Effective date

**SECTION 1: TITLE**

This local law shall be known and may be cited as Local Law No. 1 of the Year 1995 Establishing a Safety Zone Prohibiting the use of Firearms or Dangerous Weapons within the Zone Established in the Town of Caroga.

**SECTION 2: DEFINITIONS**

For the purpose of this local law firearms shall mean any pistol or handgun, rifle, shotgun or antique firearm as defined in Section 265.00, subdivision 14 of the Penal Law of the State of New York. Dangerous weapons shall mean any weapon including, but not limited to, a bow and arrow which may be used to hunt and which is capable of causing physical injury.

### SECTION 3: LEGISLATIVE INTENT

It is the purpose of this local law to preserve and promote the health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Town of Caroga and, specifically, the inhabitants and persons who may be found within the Safety Zone created hereby.

### SECTION 4: PROHIBITED USE OF FIREARMS AND DANGEROUS WEAPONS WITHIN THE SAFETY ZONE

No person, except law enforcement officers, shall discharge a firearm or dangerous weapon as described herein on any property, whether owned by such person or not, which is encompassed in the Safety Zone, which shall be the area bounded on the east by Route 29A (Route 10), on the west by London Bridge Road (County Route 111), and on the north by Kasson Drive.

### SECTION 5: RULES AND REGULATIONS

A. The town board is hereby empowered to make and promulgate, from time to time and by order or resolution, such rules and regulations relating to the Safety Zone in the Town of Caroga.

B. For the purpose of implementing and enforcing such rules and regulations, the Town Board may impose such restrictions, limitations and conditions as the Town Board may deem appropriate.

### SECTION 6: ENFORCEMENT

The Fulton County Sheriff's Department and/or any other police officer and/or other peace officer may enforce the provisions of this local law.

### SECTION 7: PENALTIES

Any person, firm or corporation violating or permitting the violation of any provision of this local law shall be guilty of an offense and shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$500.00.

### SECTION 8: VALIDITY

If any clause, sentence or provision of this local law shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this local law.

SECTION 9: EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall become effective immediately upon its posting and filing thereof as provided by law. — *EFFECTIVE DATE AUGUST 9-1995*
