Town Board Meeting Highlights

September 13, 2023

This monthly Board meeting at Town Hall began at 6:00 PM and lasted 125 minutes (35 minutes in executive session) with 28 citizens at Town Hall and 12 households via zoom.

NYS DEC announced a \$51,315.00 grant award to the Town of Caroga for a pilot study of the aquatic herbicide ProcellaCOR to combat invasive Eurasian watermilfoil in East and West Caroga Lakes. SOLitude Lake Management's Glenn Sullivan is submitting APA and DEC permits for May 2024 herbicide application in pilot test sites mapped in 2023.

Resolutions / Local Laws:

1. Lakes Management —

- Accepted the DEC Mohawk River Watershed Award of \$46,650.00 (with 10% local match) for ProcellaCOR pilot study to control Eurasian watermilfoil in the Caroga Lakes (4-0 vote)
- Approved 2 DEC grant applications for 3-year periods: (1) \$100,000.00 (25% match) for Lakes Management with DASH and ProcellaCOR and (2) \$100,000.00 (25% match) for Lake Stewards with Boat Wash Decontamination and Educational Programs (4-0 vote)
- Approved disposal of the 20 HP outboard motor used by the Weed Control Boat (4-0 vote)

2. Golf Course —

- Reserve Funds Created 2 golf course Reserve Funds: (1) maintenance/improvement project contractual expenses over \$10,000.00 and (2) capital equipment purchases over \$10,000, with each Fund set at \$1.00 and final funding to be approved 12/2023 (4-0 votes)
- Golf Budget Changes Approved the following adjustments (4-0 vote)
 A2025.20 Revenue Received Merch Sale \$3,959.00 To: A7180.42 Golf Course Merch \$3,959.00

3. **Highway Department** — (4-0 votes)

- Given revenue just submitted for year-to-date culvert sales, approved a budget adjustment: DA2665 Rev/Sale Equip \$15,370.00+DA2770 \$4,025.72 To:DA5130.4 Machinery C/E \$19,395.72
- Approved \$8,427.62 (DA5130-20) Bob Cat V-plow purchase for Superintendent's truck

- Approved 2023-2024 employee health insurance plan continued with CDPHP (4-0 vote)
- To close the annual landfill monitoring, approved \$5,755.00 net price change for C.T. Male Technical Services Contract (4-0 vote)
- Approved bills as presented for audit (4-0 vote); approved 7/12, 8/9, 8/21 minutes (4-0 vote)
