Town Board Meeting Highlights

February 14, 2024 Monthly Meeting

TownOfCaroga.com contains all issues of the Caroga News Flash.

This monthly meeting began at 6:30 PM and lasted 80 minutes with 30+ citizens at Town Hall and 24 participants on zoom. (Technical problems disrupted the zoom connection.)

The meeting featured a 30-minute public hearing and Town Board discussion of the proposed Local Law 2024 #1: Short-Term Residential Rental Law of the Town of Caroga.

- Committee Chair and Board Member Barb DeLuca expressed gratitude for community input.
- Supervisor Ralph Palcovic noted support for Caroga's tourism economy while maintaining standards of public safety and protecting residential neighborhoods for working families.
- Changes are being made to align better with the intent and purpose of the proposed law.
 - o All "short-term residential rentals" meeting the law's definitions require annual permits.
 - o Permits will be revokable and non-transferrable. Permit posting will be mandatory.
 - o All guests must be informed about invasive species prevention and boat washing.
 - In Section 10, each requirement will have a specific reference (e.g., to relevant section of NYS Building Code, DOS / DEC / DOH Codes, Town of Caroga Zoning Ordinance).
 - o The revision will include a severability clause to protect separate parts of the law.
 - o Work is also underway on the permit application and a "good neighbor" welcome letter.
 - o The revised proposed local law will be posted for public review on the town website.
 - Another hearing will be held before final adoption of the Short-Term Rental Local Law.
- Note that Fulton County Solid Waste Management Law #260-42 disallows Transfer Station
 use and residential garbage pickup for commercial entities including Short-Term Rentals.
 For Fulton County Department of Solid Waste commercial garbage permits, call 518-736-5504.
